# LIF: Leaders in Innovation Fellowships 2025

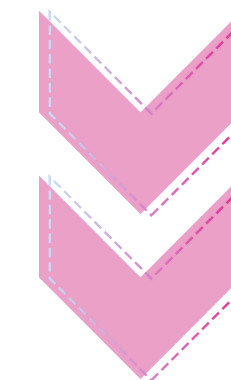
- PMUC as the official partner in 2025 will help to promote and operate as in-country partner in Thailand.

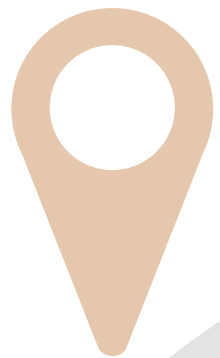

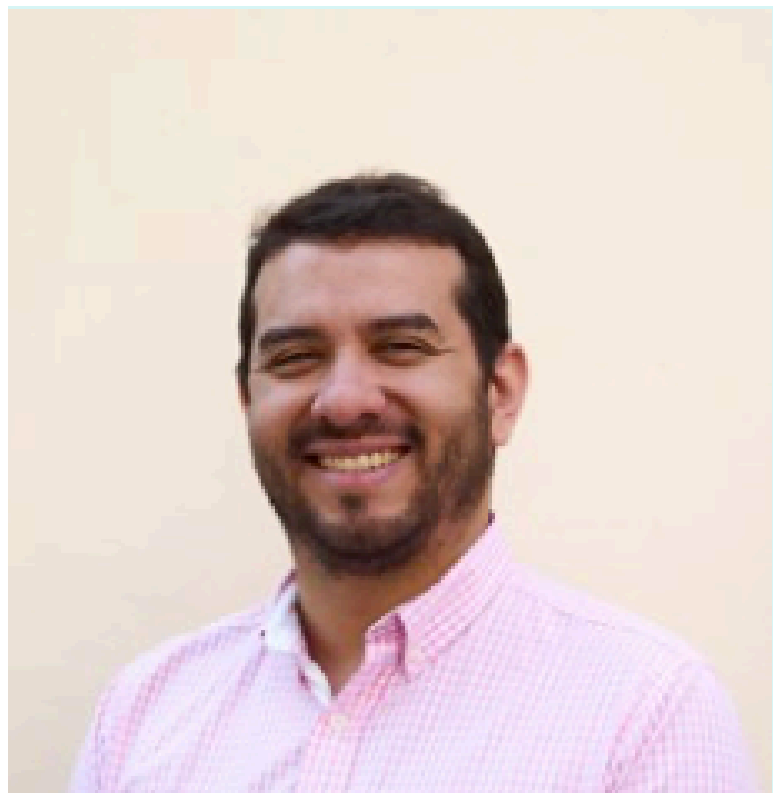


# LIF Advance: Criteria

- LIF alumni (LIF 1–7, LIF Global 22–24) or the one who are working on technology solutions to the thematic problem From Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Kenya, Malaysia, Mexico, Peru, Philippines, South Africa, Thailand, Türkiye, Vietnam.
- TRL > 7
- Theme: Biodiversity, Food security, New materials, Energy
- Candidates will need to demonstrate fluency in English to participate.

- Time commitment:
  - minimum of 10 hours during the ‘welcome week’ of the onboarding and beginning of the remote training (early-January)
  - at least 20 days for training and mentoring between January and July,
  - minimum of 12 days for the UK Residential in June-July 2025.
- Applicants must be interested in exploring partnership, funding, or other development opportunities in the UK innovation ecosystem, or establishing their business in the UK.
- Applicants must be committed to Academy value. (See from the webpage)
