- Two programmes launched by 2025 for Thailand; LIF Global and LIF Advance to Thai innovators.







LIF Advance: Criteria

• LIF alumni (LIF 1-7, LIF Global 22-24) or the one who are working on technology

solutions to the thematic problem From Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Jordan, Kenya, Malaysia, Mexico, Peru, Philippines, South Africa, Thailand, Türkiye, Vietnam.

- TRL > 7
- Theme: Biodiversity, Food security, New materials, Energy
- Candidates will need to demonstrate fluency in English to participate.





LIF Advance: Criteria

- Time commitment:
 - minimum of 10 hours during the 'welcome week' of the onboarding and beginning of the remote training (early-January)
 - at least 20 days for training and mentoring between January and July,
 - minimum of 12 days for the UK Residential in June-July 2025.
- Applicants must be interested in exploring partnership, funding, or other development opportunities in the UK innovation ecosystem, or establishing their business in the UK.
- Applicants must be committed to <u>Academy value.</u> (See from the webpage)
